What Is LAN'taFlex?

LAN'taFlex is a curb-to-curb, point deviation public transit service provided by LANTA which is designed to meet mobility needs in the more suburban communities of the Lehigh Valley in the most efficient way. LAN'taFlex service allows passengers to travel within a defined area, or Flex Zone.



How Does It Work?

To be eligible, trips must either travel entirely within the Flex Zone. When traveling from within the Flex Zone to destinations outside the Flex Zone, riders can be picked up at any address within the defined Flex Zone and be brought to one of the LAN'taBus transit stops located in the zone where they can transfer to the LAN'taBus fixed route that serves that transfer location.



How Do I Make A Reservation?

Riders must call 888-253-8333 to make a reservation for their trip at least one day in advance or 14 days prior to date of travel (the day prior to the date of your trip, or the previous Friday for Monday trips). Our reservation agent will also need to know the address where you will be traveling from and the address to where you will be traveling within the Flex Zone.
