The AFBA holds a 4 day bluegrass festival the first weekend in August. Camping, children under 12, and youth activities are FREE (with an adult full fest ticket). It makes for a very affordable family activity in the Lehigh Valley neighborhood!! The youth activities include: Youth Academy for children that want to learn to play a few songs on a bluegrass instrument, then perform as a group on Sunday afternoon, an arts and crafts program including tie-dye t-shirts, campfire with s'mores and a movie night. There are two stages with over 20 performing bands, adult workshops, an official jam tent, plus campsite jams throughout our 30 acre Mountain View park. Vendors supply food, drink and craft options.

From September thru May we hold monthly events called Shindigs with performers, jams and music lessons. The May and September Shindigs are held at the park with camping available.
